Impact on Pupils' Participation and Attainment

The funding has had a positive impact across all areas:

- Staff confidence and skills: Improved staff confidence and competence in teaching PE and sport through extensive CPD and external coaching support.
- Increased participation: More pupils are taking part in extra-curricular sports clubs and competitive events, including targeted support for girls, SEND pupils, and disadvantaged pupils through free or subsidised clubs.
- Enhanced opportunities: Specialist focused activities have improved engagement for girls, while top-up swimming sessions have supported pupils requiring additional assistance.

PE and swimming attainment:

- 100% of Year 6 pupils can swim 25m competently and use a range of strokes effectively.
- 64% can perform safe self-rescue in various water-based situations.

Sustainability of Improvements

To ensure long-term benefits:

- Staff training (CPD) has built the capacity to deliver high-quality PE lessons independently.
- Investment in durable sports equipment supports ongoing curriculum delivery.
- Extra-curricular and competitive opportunities are embedded within the school calendar.
- A strong focus on inclusivity ensures that all pupils, regardless of background or ability, continue to access sport.
