In accordance with statutory requirements, the following performance measures are published based on the most recent data for the academic year 2024–2025:

Progress Scores

Attainment at the End of Key Stage 2

- Percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths (combined): 91% (National: 62%)
- Percentage of pupils achieving a higher standard in Reading, Writing and Maths (combined): 0% (National: 8%)

• Reading: 108.1 (National: 106.0)

• Maths: 104.2 (National: 105.0)
